The California State University, Fullerton Police Department, under the supervision of Police Chief Raymund Aguirre, is an accredited agency through the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA). The California State University, Fullerton Police Department is scheduled for an assessment as part of a reaccreditation process to verify the department continues to meet professional standards. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the assessment will be conducted virtually on July 6, 2020.

CALEA's accreditation program strives to improve the delivery of public safety services by maintaining a body of standards. The program requires agencies to comply with state-of-the-art standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations, and support services.
